- Awareness of new supplies in the region.
- Awareness of increased survivability during tactical operations.
- Knowledge of law enforcement procedures in an active shooter event.
- Awareness of a joint EMS-law enforcement response guideline and dispatch protocol in the region.

Target Audience:

Emergency Medical Services (EMS) providers (both days) and local and regional law enforcement (day two).

Day 1 is tactical medicine and is designed primarily for EMS providers; however, if any local law enforcement officers are interested in the day 1 portion of the class, we will try to make sure there is room for you.
